

4. Volunteer Position Description: Classroom Helper

- **Position Title:** Volunteer Classroom Helper
- **Organization:** PPLA PCS
- **Location:** On Site
- **Reports To:** Classroom Teacher and/or Volunteer Coordinator
- **Purpose:** To provide valuable support to teachers within the classroom setting, assisting with various tasks that enhance the learning environment and allow the teacher to focus more directly on instruction and student needs.
